



# ODWHA Championship Day 2019

## March 30 & 31

---



Congratulations to your teams, staff and supporters for your success this season. As you prepare for Championship day, please read the following information as it serves as pertinent information for the day.

- Teams should be ready to play 25 minutes before their scheduled start time.
- Gamesheets will be prepared by the ODWHA ahead of time. Your team is responsible for attaching the pre-printed ODWHA watermarked labels.
- Gamesheets cannot be removed from the registration desk for any reason.
- No call-ups are permitted unless approved by the ODWHA registrar according to our guidelines.

**NOTE:** Shootout guidelines for Championship Day are as follows:

- The coach must identify the first 5 shooters on the gamesheet, up to 10 minutes before the game start.
- Shooters are to be identified as S1, S2, S3, S4, and S5. If the shooters have not been identified, the shootout order will start with the first eligible skater listed on the gamesheet.
- In the event the game is not decided after S3, the next shooter will be S4. If no winner is determined after S4, it will go to S5. If still no winner is determined, the order goes with the first eligible player at the top of the game sheet label.

### STAFF

- Timekeepers, scorekeepers, and officials have been scheduled for your game. Only game officials are permitted in the timekeeper's box.
- Every team must have their own certified trainer on the bench. Any staff going on the ice to attend to an injured player shall wear a helmet. Bench staff, timekeepers/scorekeepers shall not walk across ice surface at any time this includes post-game handshakes or medal presentations. Please walk around the arena to access the players' benches and the timekeeping boxes.
- Only players are allowed on the ice for medal presentation. Players must wear their helmets during the presentation.
- An ODWHA rep or delegate will be asked to announce the players names for medal presentation. Coaches will present the medals to the players.
- A league arranged professional photographer will be present for team photos, as well as individual still and action shots. Parents are not permitted on the ice or in the designated area for the official taking of photo.

## **DRESSING ROOMS**

- Please ensure dressing rooms are kept clean and free of garbage, as we have a quick turnaround of team entering and exiting.
- Only players and bench staff/managers will be allowed in the dressing rooms. Parents, siblings etc. are to wait in the lobby or waiting areas.
- Please ensure that all players, bench staff, and parents are aware of our zero-tolerance policy.
  - If a game has to be stopped as a result of abusive and inappropriate behavior by a spectator, the game will not be started until the spectator has left the premises. If a game cannot be completed due to a substantial delay to remove a spectator, then the team to which the spectator is associated with, will forfeit the game and the spectator, the team and association will face disciplinary action.
